



Beach Parks

1. Alder Lane Beach Park is located off South Forest Beach Drive and provides beach access and restroom facilities. Metered parking is available.

2. Burkes Beach is located off William Hilton Parkway at the end of Burkes Beach Road where a limited number of metered parking spaces are available. Additional free parking, outdoor showers and restroom facilities are provided within walking distance at Chaplin Community Park. This is the only park that does not have ADA approved access to the beach.

3. Coligny Beach Park is located at the end of Pope Avenue. Restroom facilities are provided. Free parking is available behind Smokehouse Restaurant.

4. Driessen Beach Park is located off William Hilton Parkway on Bradley Beach Road. Restrooms, outdoor showers, playgrounds, picnic pavilion and a boardwalk to the beach are provided. Metered parking and beach pass parking for island residents are available.

5. Folly Field Beach is located on Folly Field Road off William Hilton Parkway. Restrooms, outdoor showers and a boardwalk to the beach are provided. Metered parking is available.

6. Islander's Beach Park is located off William Hilton Parkway on Folly Field Road. This park is open to island residents with the appropriate beach pass. Restrooms, outdoor showers, playgrounds and a boardwalk to the beach are provided.

7. Mitchelville Beach Park is located off Mitchelville Road beside Barker Field Expansion and provides beach access and restrooms. Parking is free.

Recreational Parks

1. Barker Field is located off Beach City Road on Mitchelville Road. Baseball fields, multi-purpose fields, a boardwalk with free viewing scope looking out over Port Royal Sound and restrooms are provided.

2. Chaplin Community Park is located between Burkes Beach Road and Singleton Beach Road, off William Hilton Parkway. Facilities include tennis courts, basketball courts, multi-purpose fields, walking trails, beach access, playground, outdoor shower, restroom facilities and the Town's only dog park.

3. Cordillo Tennis Courts are located off Pope Avenue on Cordillo Parkway.

4. Crossing Park and Bristol Sports Arena are located off Arrow Road on Helmsman Way. A separate entrance provides access to the outdoor roller hockey/basketball court, skate park and restroom facilities. Crossings Park provides baseball and soccer fields, interpretative trails, picnic areas, playground, restrooms and an open meadow.

5. Island Recreation Center provides restroom, multi-purpose field, pool, gymnasium, and playground facilities. Contact 843-681-7273 for more information.

6. Old School House Park is located off William Hilton Parkway and provides tennis courts, a basketball court and a soccer field.



Public Boat Ramps

1. Beaufort County Boat Ramp is located off Marshland Road. Access to Broad Creek at this location is very shallow.

2. Cross Island Landing is located off Helmsman Way under the Cross Island Parkway Bridge.



Community Parks

1. Fish Haul Creek Park is located near the end of Beach City Road. Facilities include passive trails, beach access, restrooms, picnic pavilion and observation gazebo over the marshes of Fish Haul Creek.

2. Greens Shell Community Park is located off Squire Pope Road and provides a community house, picnic pavilion, restrooms, basketball court and playground.

3. Honey Horn is located off William Hilton Parkway at the intersection of Gum Tree Road. As one of the only preserved island plantations, this park is home to a museum and many community events. Admission is coordinated through the Coastal Discovery Museum at 843-689-6767.

4. Jarvis Creek Park is located off William Hilton Parkway and provides open fields, trails, catch and release fishing and playground facilities.

5. Old House Creek Pier is located off Sterling Point and provides a fishing dock with views of Old House Creek.

6. Compass Rose Park is located on the corner of Pope Avenue and New Orleans Road. This park contains a series of covered plazas, water features and restored wetlands.

7. Shelter Cove Community Park and the Veterans Memorial at Shelter Cove Community Park are located off Shelter Cove Lane. The Park's beautiful views of Broad Creek are the backdrop of many island concerts and festivals. The Veterans Memorial honors veterans of American military service and is home of the Town's Veterans Day and Memorial Day ceremonies. Restrooms, picnic areas, and observation boardwalks are provided.

8. Xeriscape Garden located at Hilton Head Island government offices off Wexford Drive is a beautiful example of plantings requiring little water.
